

By-Laws of the Anne Arundel Girls' Lacrosse Organization

The By-Laws of the Anne Arundel Girls' Lacrosse Organization ("AAGLO") consist of: a.) All rules and regulations of the AAGLO; and, b.) All interpretations of constitutional provisions and by-laws as provided. All rules, league structure, team rosters, home field responsibilities, postponement of games, reassigning of games, minimum play, officials' fees, and forfeiture/default of contests will be determined by the Rules of Play.

ARTICLE I- Rules of Play

- A. Rules of Play shall be drafted by the Executive Board and submitted to the member organizations at the 1st quarter meeting. The Draft may be modified by line item with a majority vote within one-week (7 days) time frame. The final draft will be approved by majority vote of members. The president of the board will be the determining vote in the event of a tie.

ARTICLE II- League Assignment/Division of Play

- A. The Membership will determine the Division of Play for each league by majority vote at the 1st quarter meeting.

ARTICLE III- Dues

- A. Membership dues are established and approved by the members. Each member shall pay its dues from the previous season no later than the 1st quarter meeting. Any member failing to pay its dues at the appropriate time may result in that program receiving sanctions.

ARTICLE IV- Penalties and Disciplinary Actions

- A. Fines for missed attendance at mandatory quarterly meetings includes the following:
 - 1. 1st Offense- no fine
 - 2. 2nd Offense- \$50 fine and letter sent to violating organization's President
 - 3. 3rd Offense- \$100 fine
 - 4. 4th Offense- \$300 fine
- B. Penalties- Any organization that violates Rec and Park policy, and/or AAGLO Constitution, By-Laws or Rules of Play of the Organization (including habitual missed attendance at mandatory quarterly meetings) will be deemed as "not in good standings" with AAGLO and the following penalties will occur:
 - No voting rights
 - No Board nominations
 - No special requests recognized by Rec and Parks when submitting teams

-No All-Star nominations

These penalties will go into effect immediately as determined by majority vote of the members, and will be removed as determined by a majority vote of the members.

- C. Further disciplinary actions for any action taken by a member or its representatives which violates Rec and Parks policy, and/or AAGLO Constitution, By-Laws, or Rules of Play of the Organization shall be determined by a majority vote of the members, unless otherwise stated in the Constitution, By-Laws or Rules of Play.

ARTICLE V- Administration of Rules of Play and By-Laws

- A. Unless otherwise stated in the Rules of Play, By-Laws, or Constitution, all decisions regarding interpretation, sanctions, and enforcement of the Rules of Play, By-Laws and Constitution shall be made by a majority vote of the members.

ARTICLE VI- Financial Report

- A. The Treasurer is responsible for submitting to the Executive Board and the general membership a financial report of all income and disbursements for the Organizations' activities. This financial report is required quarterly for presentation at each quarterly meeting. Approval of the financial report is requested by the general membership.
